Last year 25 kids attended and this year the number rose significantly to 35. Ruth received positive feedback from the parents of the children. The VBS provides outreach opportunity. Ruth said that one preteen boy came but stood outside, so Ruth invited him to join the activities. The next day he brought his twin brother with him. Both brothers wore the same tattered clothes all week. After the VSB Ruth visited their home to meet the parents. She discovered that their dad is a drug attic. She was happy the kids came and the church will continue to assist the family any way they can.





The last time we reported on the church construction we included pictures of a concrete floor and a tent. We are excited to report that the walls of the church are completed. On our last visit there were 11 teenagers that accepted Christ. Ruth is planning to invite the teens to the church to watch Christian videos and serve them food. This will help disciple the new Christians and hopefully lead more to Jesus. The church is becoming a beacon of hope in an area that is a witchcraft stronghold.

The Training Center construction is coming along nicely with the outer walls completed on 2 floors. The walls of the 1st floor have been plastered and are ready for windows and doors. Classes were halted because of all the noise and dust from construction. Classes will resume soon on the first floor.





Ruth has obtained geological surveys for 2 more wells. She is in the process of getting bids to have wells installed. We do not have funding for the wells so this is a huge prayer item for TM.
