TM MINISTRIES UPDATE:

BODA BODA LIBRARY:

Twenty one public schools in Matungulu continue to enjoy services of our mobile library (nicknamed Boda boda Library, due to its use of motorcycle transport, locally called Boda boda). Thank you to Trinity Church for your support and prayers. In addition to services of books, some of the children in these schools have been able to see and touch a computer for the very first time in their lives! Last year we were serving five schools with Boda boda Library; this year we have increased to 21 public schools (around 8000 children)!

BOOK DISTRIBUTION:

There will be a book distribution on June 20 this year. Each child in the 21 schools will receive a copy of a Christian book; about 8,000 copies will be given!

TEACHERS' WORKSHOP:

We are also blessed to have a teacher from Heritage International School, Kampala, who will be going to share her skills and experience in reading with the teachers in Tala, on June 4-5, 2013. Her name is Kathleen Davis. She is from the US and will work with teachers from classes 1 to 3 (equivalent of 1st to 3rd grade). Please pray for Kathleen.

In our Medical Facility, we just got a medical nurse for our clinic. Please join us in thanking God for him and praying for his transition.
