Dear TM Ministry Partners,

This Christmas season, we want to thank you for your past support and share some ways you have helped to expand the work of TM Ministries from Tala to Ngunyumu area in Kenya!

In October, we partnered with two organizations to evangelize in Ngunyumu, sharing the gospel with both children and adults. By the end of the week, fifty-seven adults had given their lives to Christ!

The chicken project in Ngunyumu was delayed because of widespread drought. We have engaged a pastor on a part-time basis to assist sixty households with their many needs and to help them stay focused and succeed in establishing poultry production businesses.

For the borehole drilling project, the required hydrogeological survey has been completed and submitted to the Nema and Water Authority Management Organization which issues the permit.

The geological engineer has determined that, in order to get safe and sufficient drinking water, the borehole needs to be drilled at double the depth recommended earlier. Accordingly, the drilling cost will be doubled. The new depth will also require the purchase of a solar pump. Our current need to finish this project is \$12,300. As you consider year-end giving, would you consider a gift to help meet the immediate need of safe drinking water for the people of Ngunyumu?
